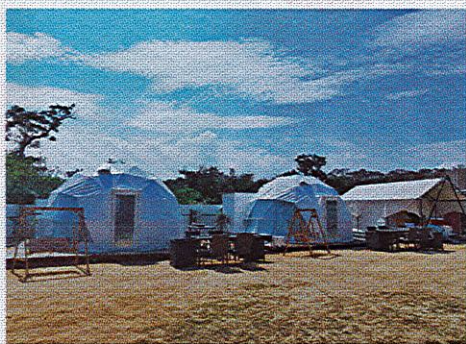
# Glamping spots

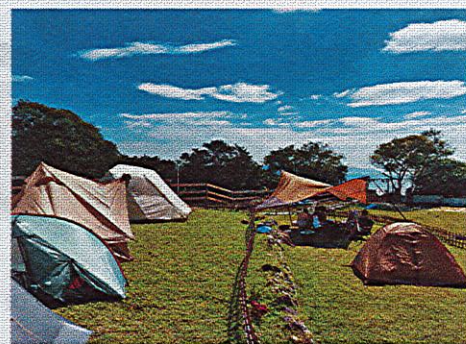
## Pastoral Glamping

LOCATED in Shek Kong, this spot has beautiful surroundings ideal for camping. It was renovated last May and features three types of special camps: sailboat camp, tribal camp and starlight camp. The campsite is also pet friendly, so you can take your pet along if you really want to enjoy a family experience.



## My Seaside Park

ON Lantau Island is a beach with beautiful scenery. Here, you can rent different types of tents like the Bohemian-themed hexagon tent or a diamond stargazing tent. But you can also bring your own tent and rent a barbecue pit. When evening comes, you can sit on the beach and watch the sunset.



## Yau Tam Mei Holiday Camp

LOCATED in Yuen Long, this spot has many features. There are 10 themed houses, each with its own features, such as Japan, princess and space. It also has a 2,000-square-foot playground. Six of the houses have transparent roofs, so you can stargaze well into the night.



## Long Coast Seasports

ALSO on Lantau Island are many watersports and equipment available for hire. You can choose to hire kayaks, bodyboards, skimboards, sailboards, soft surfboard or stand-up paddle boards. After the watersports, you can also stay the night in a teepee tent or a caravan.

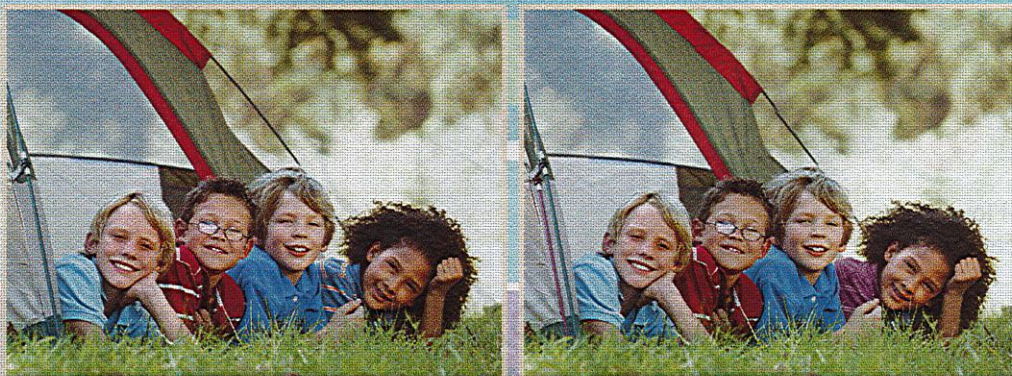
